210 Administration Goals

The administration of the School District of Random Lake is responsible for the direction, coordination and control of students and staff in their efforts to reach educational goals established jointly by the Administrators and the Board of Education. Administrators shall demonstrate leadership and be able to resolve the inevitable problems and obstacles which will arise inside the school system and in its relations with the community.

The Board expects the administration to:

1. Identify problems and needs in the District;
2. Specialize in the processes of decision making and communication;
3. Plan, organize, implement and evaluate the District's educational programs; and
4. Coordinate and guide the various stakeholders within the school system and the community so as to enable people to do things together for education that they might never be able to do separately.
